

# Sustainability Report 2024

**Our actions to reduce environmental impact and improve sustainability.**

## Executive Summary

In 2024, Something Different Wholesale Limited maintained its commitment to environmental responsibility by continuing to track and manage carbon emissions across Scopes 1, 2, and 3. This report highlights actions undertaken to reduce our carbon footprint from our base year (2022) through to 2024, highlighting key trends, achievements, and areas for further improvement.


Our total carbon footprint for 2024 was 875.47 tCO<sub>2</sub>e - a modest increase of 2.1% compared to the base year (2022: 857.26 tCO<sub>2</sub>e), while turnover intensity increased by 7.4% over the same period.

While we achieved notable reductions in areas such as fuel and electricity use, increased freight and packaging activity offset these gains. Nevertheless, our investments in cleaner energy and efforts to engage suppliers more sustainably reflect a growing maturity in our environmental approach.


## KEY ACTIONS

- Eliminated inbound air freight
- Installed 2,000 solar panels, and switched to certified renewable electricity, resulting in a reduction of over 70% in Scope 1 and 2 emissions since 2022
- Streamlined shipping services and partnered with logistics providers using lower-emission transport
- Employment of a Quality Assurance Assistant to ensure compliance with EPR and EUDR
- Purchase of a commercial-grade shredder to reuse incoming cartons as shredded filler for outbound orders
- Use of eco-friendly hexi wrap to protect delicate products, and sealing parcels with biodegradable tape
- Dedicated recycling stations throughout the business premises
- Creation of a 'Green Champions' team to proactively encourage adoption of sustainability initiatives throughout the business

## NEXT STEPS

Over the next 2-3 years, we will focus on our biggest remaining emissions sources: freight, packaging, and commuting. We'll consolidate shipments, partner with low-emission couriers, and optimise packaging using more recycled materials and smarter parcel design.

We're also promoting greener commuting through EV schemes, carpooling, and e-bikes, while continuing to upgrade energy efficiency across our buildings.
